# **PROGRAM DATES AND DURATION**

The program runs for the last two weeks of May.

### **PROGRAM FEE**

Early bird registration before 30<sup>th</sup> November: 1 235€

All other registrations: 1 535€ per student The program fee includes classes, local excursions, accommodation in Clermont Ferrand. Travel to Paris and accommodation in Paris. All other costs incurred will be borne by the student.

#### **PROGRAM REGISTRATION**

The deadline for registration is 31st March

The maximum number of students for the program is 25 and places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served based. A minimum number of 15 students is required for the program to take place. If Université Clermont-Auvergne cancels the program for any reason, program fees will be reimbursed in full. If a student decides to cancel registration before the 31st March, program fees will be reimbursed in full. Cancellations after this date will not be entitled to reimbursement. On arrival, all students must provide proof of full medical insurance including repatriation, otherwise they will not be able to attend the program and fees will not be reimbursed.
